Kate has been practicing architecture at LMN Architects since 2013, where until recently, she has had unique opportunity to focus her design efforts within five adjacent city blocks in downtown Seattle. Those projects include the recently completed Hyatt Regency Hotel, and the design of the Washington State Convention Center Addition (currently under construction) along with its two adjacent co-development towers. From large cultural projects to temporary installations, she investigates how architecture and design can support our social cultures, make space for dialogue across a multitude of perspectives, create a sense of belonging and placemaking within the public realm, and be positioned to interact with our ecosystem responsibly.
